Our goal is to encourage existing ministry initiatives and strengthen local Christians in the work God has called them to do. We desire to empower movements in the local church in order to raise up young men and women who will carry on the work of Christ into the next generation.

ABOUT PATH OF HOPE


Path Of Hope is a church-based ministry serving children affected by HIV/AIDS and extreme poverty in the Shinyanga Region of northern Tanzania. Over 90% of the population lives in rural areas, working hard to raise enough food and livestock to survive.

The dry season lasts six months of the year, and frequent droughts extend it even longer and put additional pressure on families. The region's education system is severely underdeveloped due to poverty, lack of resources, and the traditions of local people, who only consider sending children to school when younger siblings are old enough to care for the livestock. In the local towns, HIV/AIDS has fractured families and left many children to live with grandparents or relatives who are unable to provide enough support for food, clothing, and education.

Path Of Hope is working with churches in the rural villages as well as the towns to serve kids throughout the region by supporting them in their home environments. Staff and volunteers visit the children in their homes throughout the week to encourage the families, pray with them, and assess their needs.

Saturday mornings find the Path of Hope church sites teeming with children, ready for "program day" which includes discipleship, worship, activities, and a meal.

Children in the Sponsorship Program are cared for holistically, meaning that physical, emotional, spiritual, educational, and environmental factors are all considered in providing care for each child. The kids are all given the opportunity to attend a local school, and Lahash engages in ongoing training and development efforts with the East African staff to creatively and compassionately improve the children's lives.

ABOUT NIPE TUMAINI

When God called Benson Mungai and his wife Eunice to begin preparing a home for orphaned and vulnerable children, Benson didn't start by looking for kids in need. First, he planted a garden. Today that garden has grow into a farm that spreads out for acres in front of Nipe Tumaini Children's Home in Kenya's Rift Valley. Benson's vision was not only to create a safe home where children would receive love and holistic care. He wanted Nipe Tumaini to be a sustainable children's home. "We believe sustainability is the way to go, for any project or organization to succeed," he explains.

At Nipe Tumaini, the children live in a family-style setting where meals, work, and space are all shared communally. In addition to their studies, the children each have home responsibilities. They assist with cleaning and cooking, wash clothes and shoes, and help out on the farm. Many of the children have come from backgrounds of abandonment and abuse, so a stable and loving home environment is a critical part of restoring their hopes and re-imagining their futures.

Children in the Sponsorship Program are cared for holistically, meaning that physical, emotional, spiritual, educational, and environmental factors are all considered in providing care for each child. The kids at this location attend school on site at Nipe Tumaini Academy. Lahash engages in ongoing training and development efforts with the East African staff to creatively and compassionately improve the children's lives.








PRAY FOR GRACE & HEALING MINISTRY

ABOUT GRACE & HEALING MINISTRY

Dodoma is the capital city of Tanzania, home to everyone from wealthy Members of Parliament to destitute urban poor. Founded by Esther Muhagachi, Grace & Healing Ministry began as a group of women from a local church whose hearts were moved by the plight of those left most vulnerable in Dodoma, due to the impact of poverty and HIV/AIDS. As they were getting established, Esther approached Lahash about starting a Sponsorship Program to care for children whose needs would otherwise remain overlooked.

Most of the children in the Sponsorship Program have lost one or both of their parents. environmental factors are all considered in They are cared for by a single parent, extended providing care for each child. The kids are all family, or family friends. Grace & Healing Ministry staff visit the children at home, offering counseling and prayer, as well as advocacy with teachers and doctors when needed.

Some of the older children are "childheaded households," meaning that no adult caregiver is present in the home, so they receive additional support. Every Friday afternoon, the sponsored children gather at the church to participate in a program of Bible teaching, choir practice, games, counseling, and a meal. Many walk for miles to come enjoy this weekly event. In addition, a Nutrition Program provides a daily meal for the children who are HIV-positive.

Children in the Sponsorship Program are cared for holistically, meaning that physical, emotional, spiritual, educational, and given the opportunity to attend a local school, and Lahash engages in ongoing training and development efforts with the East African staff to creatively and compassionately improve the children's lives.

- Pray for our beneficiaries who continue to struggle with food security and housing because in Rwanda the prices continue to increase in the market.


ABOUT ERM-RWANDA

Our church and ministry partners in Rwanda have been serving orphans since 1996. Through partnership with Lahash, the ministry is expanding into the rural outskirts of the city of Kigali where a new generation of vulnerable children are struggling against poverty, disease, and lack of education.

ERM-Rwanda works directly with the community in the area to identify the children most in need of sponsorship and assistance. Through regular visits to their homes, program staff and volunteers offer support and counsel to each child, as well as making sure that medical and educational needs are being met. Each Saturday all the sponsored children gather together at the ministry center for worship, Biblical teaching, activities, and a meal.

Children in the Sponsorship Program are cared for holistically, meaning that physical, emotional, spiritual, educational, and environmental factors are all considered in providing care for each child. The kids are all given the opportunity to attend a local school, and Lahash engages in ongoing training and development efforts with the East African staff to creatively and compassionately improve the children's lives.



ABOUT PEACE MAKERS FOR ALBINISM & COMMUNITY

Tanzania has the highest rate of albinism in the world. This genetic condition affects anywhere from 25,000 to 150,000 people in the nation. In addition to the serious health problems that result from lack of melanin, people with albinism face intense stigma and discrimination. Since the year 2000, more than 75 people with albinism have been killed. Most commonly they are bullied, shamed, beaten, chased from school, and maimed for body parts to be used for witchcraft and superstitious beliefs.

Sister Martha Mganga was born with albinism in northern Tanzania. She faced psychological and emotional abuse from her father as well as from her neighbors. At one point she even attempted suicide because of the abuse and stigma related to her condition. She still faces constant threats of violence and danger. But she is determined to advocate for children with albinism and change the way it is perceived.

She founded Peace makers for Albinism & community to provide direct advocacy and care for several dozen children with albinism who haveendured multiple forms of trauma, and they are now making significant progress in their emotional and spiritual recovery. Albino Peacemakers is helping families accept and love their kids with albinism, and they are spreading the message across Tanzania that people with albinism are normal people worthy of kindness and compassion. Children in the Sponsorship Program are cared for holistically, meaning that physical, emotional, spiritual, educational, and environmental factors are all considered in providing care for each child. The kids are all given the opportunity to attend a local school, and Lahash engages in ongoing training and development efforts with the East African staff to creatively and compassionately improve the children's lives.



2024 LAHASH PRAYER GUIDE

PRAY FOR THE STAND WITH STUDENTS PROGRAM

Thank God for students who completed their studies. In 2023, we witnessed six graduations. Four students from Tanzania graduated with bachelor degrees, one student from Tanzania graduated with a diploma and one student from Uganda graduated with a bachelor degree. Thank God for these achievements. Pray Grace and blessings over the students who graduated in the year 2023 as they figure out their career paths and next steps.

Pray for students who will be joining SWS/colleges/universities in 2024.

Pray that God will guide them as they navigate all of the logistics of getting classes, meeting lecturers, and getting accommodations in the hostels. That God will surround them with friends who will challenge them to walk more closely with Christ and that God will guide them to churches where they can serve and worship while at their colleges/universities. That God will help them to work hard, to study well and to use their time to develop skills and gifts for God's purposes.

Pray for protection over all SWS students. Pray that as they encounter challenges in colleges and universities God will help them love Him with their whole hearts. That as they hear different philosophies, God will help them love Him with their whole minds. That as the enemy prowls around tempting them with all manner of worldliness, God will help them love Him with all their strength, that they will have courage to follow hard after Him and to glorify Him where He has placed them.







Pray for discernment during decision making. Pray that the students will have eyes to see God and ears to hear Him as they navigate big decisions about their courses, internships, relationships and their future. That God will bring clarity to their decisions and peace as they make them. That God will Help the students to seek His will above their own. That God will help them to know the purposes He has for each one of them. That God will help them to be patient as He reveals His perfect will for them. That God will open doors widely and close them loudly as He leads them.

Pray for Provision. Thank God earnestly for the people who have always been providing funds for the SWS program over the years. Ask God to meet students' financial needs in the year 2024. That God will provide for their housing and accomodation needs, their transportation needs, their healthcare needs, their food and utilities, for their tuition fees, and their stationery.
