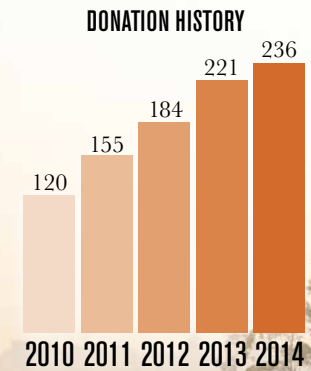
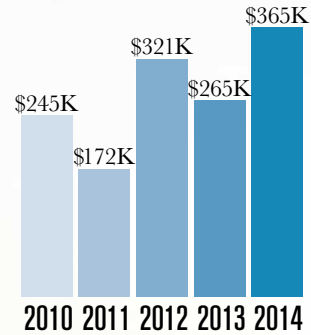


# 2014 FINANCIAL SUMMARY

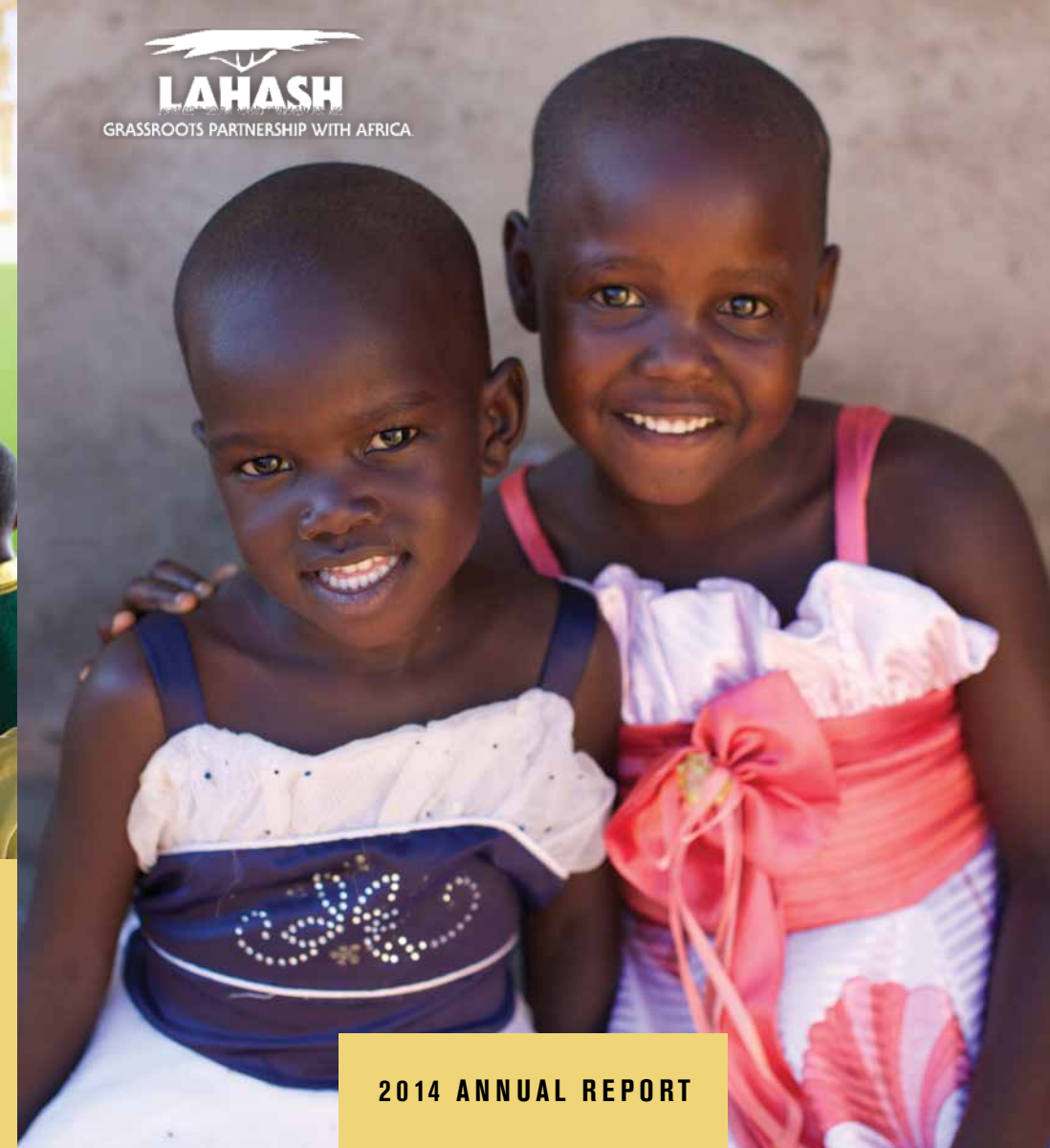

At Amazing Grace Children's Home in Uganda, the children were in desperate need of a new kitchen. For the home to remain open, local health officials required that a new permanent kitchen and dining room be constructed. In response to this need, Lahash launched a crowd-funding campaign called 26Together. Communities from all over the US and East Africa rallied together and raised over \$13,000 to make sure these precious kids received the new kitchen they needed!
