General Description of Work

The Development Director is a new position at Lahash. This role will include creating a comprehensive fundraising strategy to help accomplish the vision of Lahash. The Development Director will then work with the Program Directors at Lahash and with the other team members to help implement this strategy in order to successfully reach the goals of the Lahash Strategic Plan.

Essential Functions

1. Personal Fund Development

- a. Raise an amount of financial support mutually agreed upon
- b. Work to establish and maintain a personal team of donors, advocates, and prayer partners to support the ministry work

2. Oversee Development planning and implementation at Lahash

- a. Work with the Executive Director to create a compressive yearly fundraising plan that includes all departments and programs at Lahash
- b. Organize and lead the annual Lahash Celebration Fundraising banquet in Portland, Oregon for 400-500 individuals
- c. Assist with an overhaul of the Lahash donor database and streamline procedures
- d. Work with the Media Team to creatively utilize multiple mediums and platforms to raise funds each year for the mission of Lahash
 - i. Oversee fundraising efforts on social media
 - ii. Enhance the Lahash.org website to be a better resource for large donors, small donors, and sponsors
 - iii. Lead several yearly campaigns utilizing print resources to increase donations from both new and existing donors
- e. Plan and facilitate several Lahash gatherings each year in both the Pacific Northwest and across the United States that will increase connections with the story and vision of Lahash and provide opportunities for deeper engagement and increased giving.

- f. Research trends and data to provide input during the year to mature the fundraising efforts of the staff, Servant Team, East African Partners, and each of the Lahash programs
 - g. Assemble and empower a team of Lahash Advocates who can champion the cause and vision of Lahash and assist with messaging and awareness throughout the year
 - h. Oversee gratitude efforts at Lahash in response to giving and service
3. **Lahash Community Participation**
- a. Attend the weekly Lahash evening meal with the Portland community (Mondays)
 - b. Attend the Lahash East Africa Conference every two years
 - c. Participate in the annual U.S. staff retreat
 - d. Attend the monthly solitude days and various other spiritual and educational growth events for the Lahash team
 - e. Travel at least once per year to East Africa to work alongside the East African Partners and to gain new insights into the ministry of Lahash
